



What is the Dorset Care Record?

The Dorset Care Record (DCR), launched in March 2018, is an electronic repository providing a consolidated view of information from health and social care systems across Dorset.

Through collaboration of the partner organisations, DCR is enabling better sharing of information for health and care professionals, to enable details of a person's medical or care needs, to be summarised in the same place and improve the care of people in Dorset.

DCR currently brings together information from Dorset hospitals and GPs. Work is underway to bring in further information from hospitals, community health teams and social care information from Dorset councils.

The Dorset Care Record

Dorset Care Record provides a joined up view of information from partner systems for the first time in Dorset.

Sharing appropriate information electronically to a single place offers direct access for authorised health and social care professionals, to provide as full a picture as possible of a person's history, needs, support and service contacts.



In the longer term, the aim is to offer the residents of Dorset access to their own record, through a citizen portal.




DCR Case study: 'Showered with Help'

A Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council spokesperson told us:

An 84 year old gentleman was becoming dizzy in the shower and having trouble standing up.

He requested a seat, but did not meet the eligibility criteria through the line of questioning.

The DCR showed that he was on some medication which meant he was in fact eligible, and was provided with the equipment he needed.



OCR Case study: 'Safeguarding vulnerable patients' Understanding the medications that members of the public are taking and also potentially safeguarding vulnerable patients have been two areas where the Dorset Care Record has helped respiratory nurse consultant Natalie Harper.

Although based at Dorset County Hospital, much of Natalie's work is traditionally carried out at outpatients clinics at Weymouth, Bridport and Blandford. She finds that well over 50 per cent of people are not aware of medications they've been prescribed.

Natalie said the DCR had recently flagged up a safeguarding issue: "I had a new referral from a GP practice – a young person who had recently moved into the area. Nothing was highlighted on the referral but the GP summary information on the DCR flagged up a possible issue of domestic abuse.

"This rang alarm bells and I then had a phone call from a member of the public who said please use this number when ringing for the consultation. I then contacted the referred person's former GP surgery which highlighted potential issues."

Steps have been taken to ensure that the person can now talk in a safe environment, and they have been very grateful.

What is Wessex Care Records? The background

- NHS England and Local Government Association initiative in 2018 to join up health and social care records from grass roots up.
- Known as the Local Health and Care Record (LHCR).
- WCR is an LHCRE (E = Exemplar) and one of the first five to be awarded funding.
- LHCR programme is part of NHSX mandate (joining up data across population and place).
- WCR builds upon the two existing care record programmes (DCR and CHIE) to improve access across geographical borders.
- Another is the development of a population health analytics platform (Intelligent Working Programme and Population Health Management).
- Focus is on improving access to information for everyone clinicians, health and care professionals and people.



WCR has five priorities





The Wessex work package

Work package agreed between the three Wessex teams (WCR, DCR and CHIE) in February 2020

- The proposal consists of three parts;
 - 1. Local Record Locator (LRL) A live look up between DCR and CHIE placing a "flag" in the local patient record.
 - 2. Single Sign On between DCR and CHIE Using SAML to establish an in-context, RBAC appropriate link to the neighbouring portal and patient record.
 - 3. Aggregated Data views Aggregated views of data to be exposed in the local patient record. Enhanced use of SSO when needed to link to the relevant part of the neighbouring record as needed.

There is a fourth item in the proposal relating to **One Medication Record**, this will be managed as a separate work package.



One Medication

- A single medication record across Wessex within the shared care records (CHIE and Dorset Care Record) using the Orion health platform.
- Building on the existing interfaces being developed within the DCR and CHIE
- The record will act as a central repository to allow a bi-directional interface using FHIR messaging
- The platform ingests, stores and aggregates data from multiple external provider source systems in near real-time and surfaces the consolidated record to support point of care delivery.

Security and Confidentiality



All access to information is via a highly secure access portal limited to approved NHS and Local Authority health and social care professionals.



By law, everyone working in, on behalf of, the NHS and social care must follow strict information governance rules designed to respect patient privacy and keep information safe.



The DCR Partnership has signed up to the Dorset Information Sharing Charter (DiSC) which governs how we share personal data with each other, in line with legislation.



The DCR will keep a record of everyone who has accessed a record, the time and date when they have accessed it and the information they were viewing.

The laws on data protection are clear and we take them very seriously.

Security of Records

DCR has a range of safeguards in place to protect information, including:



Sharing Personal Information



Everyone working in, or on behalf of, the NHS and social care must follow strict information governance rules designed to respect citizen privacy and keep all information safe.



As DCR partners are members of the Dorset Information Sharing Charter (DiSC) agreements are already in place to share data in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).



All Dorset citizens will have a Dorset Care Record available to health and social care professionals who are providing direct care. A citizen has the right to opt out of the DCR if they wish (covered later in this module).

Dorset Information Sharing Charter



The Dorset Information Sharing Charter (DiSC) provides Dorset partner agencies with a robust foundation for the lawful, secure and confidential sharing of personal information between themselves and other public, private or voluntary sector organisations that they work, or wish to work in partnership with.

Signing up to the DiSC is the first step for a community pharmacy in arranging access to the DCR.









Summary Care Record

- The Summary Care Record is used nationally and only a snapshot of your GP record goes through to the Dorset Care Record.
- If people have opted out of the SCR they will still need to opt out of the DCR.

Dorset Care Record

- The Dorset Care Record provides a more detailed view of your health and care treatment from your local NHS and social care organisations.
- This includes 3 acute hospitals (RBCH, Poole and DCH), community and mental health (DHC), GP practices (CCG), two local authorities (BCP and DC). We are also providing feeds to Yeovil District Hospital


